EXPOSURE AND EXPLOSION HAZARD.

Tank contains corrosive anhydrous ammonia under high pressure.

- Anhydrous ammonia is a hazardous and corrosive substance. Stress corrosion cracking leading to catastrophic tank failure and immediate rupture can occur in nurse tanks.
- Wear appropriate protective clothing at all times.
- Inhalation hazard: if exposed to anhydrous ammonia, flush the area with water and seek immediate medical attention.
- Use this tank only as a nurse tank with anhydrous ammonia. Do not place propane gas or any other substance in this tank.
- Anhydrous ammonia should be used only outdoors and in a well-ventilated environment.
